Sir

Your instructions regarding mail matter for Edinburg Bethanie and Reddersburg being made up in separate packets and to be included in Fauresmith, has been noted and shall be carried out. They were hitherto ^{not} sent to Bloemfontein but as separate packets ~~sent~~ in a second bag labelled Colesberg. Mails for Colesberg alone were put in the first bag.

1876 On "Her Majesty's Service" folded letter from Port Elizabeth (April 21, 1876) to the Postmaster General of Cape Town (April 24).
