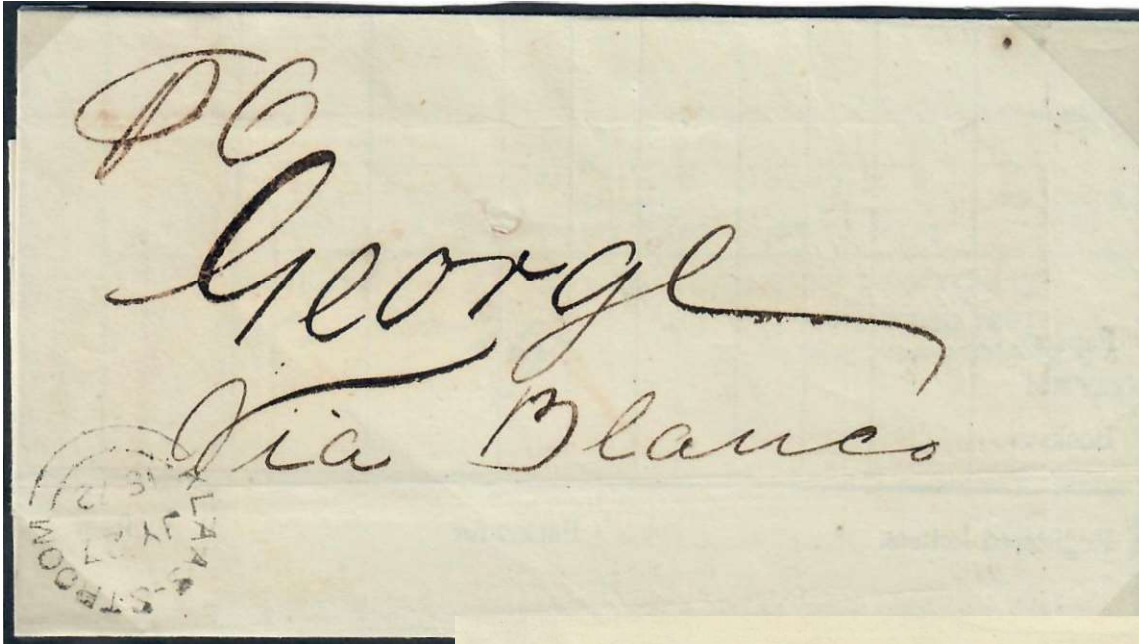

Postmaster Receiving.

1872 Internal P.O. "Letter of Despatch advice" printed format (175 x 214 mm) folded and sent out as an official entire from the post office at Klaas-Stroom confirming letters despatched to George on "JY 27 1872", addressed to P.O. George via Blanco advice would have accompanied the relevant mail despatch between offices, advice bears two fine strikes (both inside and on the address side) of the extremely rare "double arc" cancel of Klaas-Stroom "JY 27 1872"

Putzel records "it is unlikely that identifiable mail exists from Klaas- Stroom".
