CORK OBLITERATORS IDENTIFIABLE

The majority of the cork obliterations were used on parcels and few are known to have survived on piece or entires, making it almost impossible to allocate them to any specific office. A few Postmasters were cutting their "corks" to resemble the initials of towns of origins.
