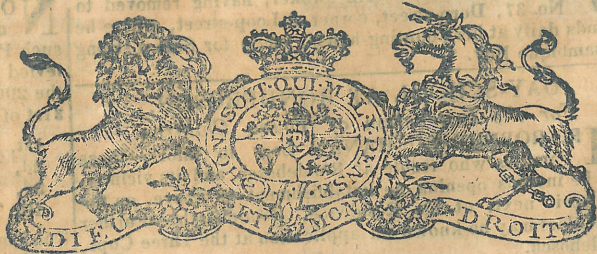


**NEWSPAPER DUTY**

The Gazette bears the 1d newspaper duty rate and the supplement is taxed at 1/2d.

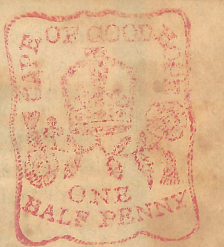
