

THE QV COLOURLESS EMBOSSED ISSUE – THE “LICENCE” STAMPS

“ADHESIVE STAMPS”

De La Rue records report that a number of “temporary stamps” were supplied with the first order - embossed on gummed paper. These are observed on documents used in 1865-67.

3 July 1866


£4/10/- duty paid with 1825 £2,
2 X Type 1 £1 “**adhesive stamps**” and a Type 1 10/-
“**adhesive stamp**”. (Transfer duty on a price of £1500 to £1600 was £4/10/-.



1 August 1866

£3/10/- duty paid with embossed Type 1 £3 and a Type 1 10/- “**adhesive stamp**”.
(Transfer duty on a price of £1100 to £1200 was £3/10/-.
